Council President Jenny Folsom called the Cullman City Council Meeting to order at 7:01 o'clock p.m. on Monday, December 17th, 2018. Fire Chief Brian Bradberry presented the invocation.

CITY OF CULLMAN RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 26

WHEREAS, City of Cullman is proposing to apply to ADECA for Land and Water Conservation Fund grant assistance to implement a Nesmith Park Enhancement Project; and WHEREAS, the City of Cullman intends to make application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs for LWCF funding assistance to construct the Nesmith Park Enhancement Project; and

WHEREAS, said programs are limited to funding a maximum of \$350,000 of the proposed project construction cost estimated at \$878,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City of Cullman will commit to provide \$528,000 in local matching funds in the form of cash and in-kind services, as well all cost associated with engineering design and administrative services for the purpose of implementing the City's Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant Project, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event the grant is awarded, the City of Cullman understands that it will sign assurance to comply with all applicable Federal and State Law, rules and regulations.
