**RESOLUTION NO. 2020 – 74
Of the City Council of the City of Cullman**

WHEREAS, the Industrial Development Board has contacted the Mayor as to a project by HomTex to develop and manufacture medical and nonmedical mask to help defeat the COVID-19 virus not only in Cullman, the State of Alabama but nationally; and

WHEREAS, HomTex has requested a loan of 1.5 million dollars for a period not to exceed two years at a rate of 2.2 percent; and

WHEREAS, IDB will require a loan from the City of Cullman; and

WHEREAS, the project is extremely important not only to defeat the national emergency of COVID-19 virus but would create jobs and revenue for the citizens in the City of Cullman.

THEREFORE, the City Council hereby sets a public hearing for a 772 project to loan IDB funds for the HomTex project on April 13, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.
