

**CULLMAN CITY COUNCIL MEETING ON MAY 29, 2020 IN THE LUCILLE N. GALIN AUDITORIUM
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING**

Council President Jenny Folsom called the Cullman City Council Meeting to order at 12:23 o'clock p.m. on Monday, May 29, 2020.

A roll call by City Clerk Wesley Moore reflected the following: Present - Mayor Woody Jacobs, Council Member Andy Page, President Pro Tem Johnny Cook, Council Member David Moss, Council Member Clint Hollingsworth and Council President Jenny Folsom. Also present were City Attorney Roy Williams and City Clerk Wesley Moore.

RESOLUTIONS, ORDINANCES, ORDERS, AND OTHER BUSINESS

Council Member Moss made a motion to adopt the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 87
AUTHORIZING NON-ASSIGNABLE CONTRACT FOR PROMOTION OF THE CITY OF CULLMAN
AND THE CITY'S BRAND AT MUSIC EVENT ON JUNE 5, 2020**

Whereas, Real World Tours, Inc. has engaged Alan Jackson to perform a family friendly concert in Cullman, Alabama; and

Whereas, the City of Cullman to promote the City, provide an event locally which is COVID-19 friendly, and create a boost to the economic health of the City with one of Alan Jackson's concerts to occur in the City of Cullman; and

Whereas, the City of Cullman has determined that as one of the sponsors of the event, it will create a boost to the economy, provide positive promotion of the City, which in time will create other economic opportunities for its citizens and provide a COVID-19 friendly venue.

It is Resolved as follows:

1. The Mayor is directed to contract with the Real World Tours, Inc. to promote a concert within the City of Cullman performed by Alan Jackson known as the Alan Jackson Small Town Drive In.
2. The City of Cullman will pay to Real World Tours, Inc. the sum of \$19,275, which shall be for the promotion of the City of Cullman and its brand in not less than 12 publication of local Southeastern and National distribution, including Rolling Stones Country, MSN Money, USA Today, Tennessean, Al.com, Taste of Country, Yellow Hammer, The Boot, Nash Country Dailey, and others. Provide Facebook and other media promotion naming the City of Cullman as one of its sponsors including interviews on CBS 42, ABC 33/40, and NBC WVTM 13.

3. Real World Tours, Inc. request the City to assist them in quickly preparing a site for the performance by cleaning and soil preparation for a maximum of 2,000 vehicles and to provide reasonable number of policeman, fire trucks, operators, first aid equipment, and personnel to assist in parking vehicles for the drive in performance and police officers for the venue.

4. Real World Tours, Inc. shall pay the City its cost in providing all assistance concerning work, equipment, and personnel in paragraph 3 above.

5. Real World Tours, Inc. shall provide insurance naming the City of Cullman as additional insured covering the City and all employees for all work and labor performed for Real World Tours, Inc. for the concert.

6. There shall be no alcohol sales. Food vendors shall provide services to the vehicles limiting the social interaction and assist in and maintaining the social distance as recommended and required by the State of Alabama Health Officer, for the concert to be COVID-19 approved.

7. The admittance is limited to 2,000 vehicles and all occupants must remain in their designated area while attending the concert.

8. Real World Tours, Inc. shall pay all sales tax on ticket sales, on site food, and merchandise sales.

Therefore, the City Council resolves that a special permit for noise and special event be granted to Real World Tours, Inc. conditions upon the Mayor entering into a written contract containing the written requirements set out in this Resolution.
