

**CITY OF CULLMAN**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 79**

**WHEREAS** the City of Cullman desires to rehabilitate and construct new handicapped accessible sidewalks south along 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, SW from US Highway 278 to 4<sup>th</sup> Street SW and will extend west along 4<sup>th</sup> Street SW to the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW.

**WHEREAS** the City of Cullman proposes to submit an application to the Alabama Department of Transportation for grant assistance available through the FY2023 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP); and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated total project cost is \$1,080,602.39, the TAP Grant Ceiling is \$800,000.00 for construction and \$100,000.00 for design, and the program requires a cash match of at least 20% of eligible project cost.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the City of Cullman will provide the required local cash match of \$280,602.39, as well all cost associated with engineering design and administrative services; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to file an application for these funds, and in the event a grant is awarded, the Cullman City Council understands that the Mayor will be required to sign certifications and assurances to comply with applicable Federal and State laws, rules and regulations.
