NOTICE OF SERVICE CHANGE EFFECTIVE MONDAY 03-06-2023.

To ensure compliance with the EPA's **Environmental Regulations Concerning Inert** Landfills, the Sanitation/Recycling Department WILL NOT pick up grass, leaves, or other green waste materials bagged in non-biodegradable plastic bags effective March 6, 2023.

Residents who bag green waste materials must use **BIODEGRADABLE BAGS** (similar to this).—



WHY SHOULD I USE BAGS? Bagging waste materials helps prevent spillage & messes. If you use bags, they must be bio-degradable.. (During fall/winter leaf season, leaf material doesn't require bagging.)



WHERE DO I PLACE MY GREEN WASTE MATERIALS? Green waste materials should be placed within 5 feet of the curb (not in the street) and away from vehicles & mailboxes.

ARE THERE LIMITS ON WHAT CAN BE PICKED UP? Yes. Limbs must be less than 6' long, stumps & tree parts must weigh less than 75 lbs, and only 3 cubic yards can be picked up per stop. Also, no dirt, rocks, concrete, or other materials should be mixed with green waste. CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVAL OF **BRUSH & LIMBS THEY SERVICE.**
