**RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 55**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cullman, acting by and through its City Council proposes to apply to the U.S. Department of Transportation requesting grant funds from the Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant Opportunity (MPDG Grant).

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Cullman as follows:

**THAT, WOODY JACOBS, MAYOR**, is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the United States Department of Transportation requesting Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant funds in the amount not to exceed \$25,000,000 to replace the St. Bernard Bridge and widen U.S. Highway 278/State Highway 69 from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue to existing 3-lane section past St. Bernard Bridge; and

**THAT, THE CITY OF CULLMAN** will provide a local match of \$100,000 in support of this project and the Alabama Department of Transportation has committed the remainder of the project match.
