**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-08**

**TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF ALABAMA TO MAINTAIN A SERVICE ROAD  
AND STORM PIPE IN THE CITY LIMITS OF CULLMAN, ALABAMA**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Cullman, Alabama as follows:

1. That the City of Cullman, Alabama, enter into an agreement with the State of Alabama, acting by and through the Alabama Department of Transportation for the maintenance of a service road on SR-157 at MP 4.76 – 4.86 and storm pipe at the median on AL-003 MP at 329.08 to 329.26 on SR 157 in the ALDOT right-of-way from milepost 4.76 to 4.86 within the city limits of Cullman which agreement is before the Council.
2. That the Agreement be executed in the name of the City, by its Mayor, for and on its behalf;
3. That the signature of the Mayor be attested by the City Clerk and that the seal of the City be affixed to the agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the completion of the execution of the Agreement by all parties, that a copy of such Agreement be kept on record by the City Clerk.
