**WHEREAS**, City of Cullman has applied for and received a \$800,000.00 FY2026 Transportation Alternatives Program Grant (TAP) Grant #:TAPAA-TA26(900) to rehabilitate and construct new handicapped accessible sidewalks beginning at the intersection of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street SW (Highway 278) and 3rd Avenue SW and extending south along 3rd Avenue SW to 5<sup>th</sup> Street SW and then west along 5<sup>th</sup> Street SW to the intersection of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW in downtown Cullman.
