On behalf of Restoring Women Outreach, Inc., we respectfully request consideration for opioid settlement funding received by the City of Cullman in the amount of \$125,000.00.

Since 2013, Restoring Women Outreach has worked tirelessly to help women overcome addiction through accountability, structure, and love while rebuilding families and strengthening our community.

Our program serves women recovering from opioid and substance addiction through:

- 12-Step Recovery Program
- Anger Management
- Parenting Classes
- Conflict Resolution
- GED Assistance
- Wallace State ACE Program
- Life Skills and Workforce Readiness

In 2025 alone, Restoring Women Outreach served 122 women, provided 10,220 nights of housing, completed over 640 recovery and life-skills classes, and celebrated 979 sobriety milestones.

Our participants also donated more than 11,000 volunteer hours through partnerships with local organizations, including assistance with Parks and Recreation and other community efforts.

Additionally, participants paid \$91,200 back into the City and County through child support, fines, restitution, probation, and parole obligations. As our organization expands, these positive financial and community impacts are expected to double.

We are currently opening a new facility that will double our capacity and allow us to serve even more women seeking freedom from opioid addiction. This expansion will provide additional structured housing, educational opportunities, workforce development, and recovery support for women in Cullman.

We sincerely appreciate the City Council's continued support since 2013 and your commitment to helping us restore lives through accountability, recovery, and compassion.






