## Laborer (Street Department)

### Description

This is semi-skilled manual labor in connection with various construction and maintenance activities.

### Responsibilities

**Scope of Work:** Employees in this class perform physical tasks requiring some acquired skills in the use of hand or power tools, or in the operation of mechanical or related equipment. Instructions are usually received orally and routine tasks are performed with considerable independence, but more difficult work is performed under the direct supervision of a foreman or a skilled workman. Work is subject to inspection during its progress and upon completion.

**Major Job Tasks:** (All duties listed may not be found in each position. Also, this list does not necessarily include all tasks which may be assigned to positions in this class.)

- Perform rough carpentry work such as building concrete forms, wooden fences, shipping crates, and other work in connection with the construction and maintenance of water and sewer utilities, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, bridges, and buildings.
- Perform such tasks as finishing concrete and setting forms for curbs and gutters.
- Perform rough sign and other brush and spray painting work not involving difficult or original lettering; repair, fabricate, and erect metal and wooden street signs; lay out and paint center lines and lane lines in streets, crosswalks, and parking spaces.
- Operate light truck and other automotive and related equipment.
- Operate mechanical saws, cut trees and branches, and observe precautions against personal injury or property damage.
- Perform miscellaneous mechanical and maintenance repair tasks requiring familiarity with basic trade practices in carpentry, painting, masonry, plumbing, or similar operations.
- Perform related work as required.
- Any other task deemed necessary by the immediate supervisor.

### Qualifications

**Experience:** Experience in semi-skilled work in building or mechanical trades or equipment maintenance and operation.

### Knowledge & Skills:

- Knowledge of basic construction practices and procedures.
- Knowledge of common hand and power tools.
- Knowledge of machinery, equipment, and tools necessary for the maintenance of public utilities.
- Knowledge of basic preventative maintenance on assigned equipment.

- Ability to bend, stoop, and perform heavy lifting as required in this position.
- Ability to handle moderate to extreme weather conditions (temperatures, heat, rain, cold, etc.).
