

NOTICE OF SERVICE CHANGE

EFFECTIVE MONDAY 03-06-2023.

To ensure compliance with the EPA's **Environmental Regulations Concerning Inert Landfills**, the Sanitation/Recycling Department **WILL NOT** pick up grass, leaves, or other green waste materials bagged in **non-biodegradable plastic bags** effective **March 6, 2023**.

Residents who bag green waste materials must use **BIODEGRADABLE BAGS** (similar to this). →




Q **WHY SHOULD I USE BAGS?** Bagging waste materials helps prevent spillage & messes. If you use bags, they must be bio-degradable..
A *(During fall/winter leaf season, leaf material doesn't require bagging.)*

Q **WHERE DO I PLACE MY GREEN WASTE MATERIALS?** Green waste materials should be placed within 5 feet of the curb (not in the street) and away from vehicles & mailboxes.

Q **ARE THERE LIMITS ON WHAT CAN BE PICKED UP?** Yes. Limbs must be less than 6' long, stumps & tree parts must weigh less than 75 lbs, and only 3 cubic yards can be picked up per stop. Also, no dirt, rocks, concrete, or other materials should be mixed with green waste. **CONTRACTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVAL OF BRUSH & LIMBS THEY SERVICE.**
